



Call for applications Research Fellow CSR

The Research Institute for Managing Sustainability (<u>www.wu-wien.ac.at/sustainability</u>) at the Vienna University of Economics and Business announces an open position for a fulltime Research Fellow, **starting 1st July 2010 and with a duration of two years (24 months)**. The position is funded from projects and university teaching is not included among the job tasks. The position is not suitable for candidates who have just started their doctoral studies.

Responsibilities include: Independent research and assistance to the project leader in two CSR research projects (financed from EU FP7 and Austrian National Bank): literature review and quantitative and qualitative empirical research and analysis, project report writing, preparation of scientific publications, project management assistance.

Required skills and qualifications:

- Completed or far advanced doctoral degree in the area of Business management or a related discipline with a focus on Corporate Social Responsibility (CSR). Excellent academic performance.
- In-depth knowledge of current academic discourse and business practice in CSR
- Excellent English at an academic level (demonstrated through e.g. publications in international journals, presentations at international conferences, participation in international research projects)
- Project- and team-work experience (preferably in research projects)

Desired skills and qualifications:

- Familiarity with social science research methods (qualitative and quantitative data collection and analysis); evaluations research and Delphi studies preferred
- Sound knowledge of international organisations, European institutions and sustainability policy instruments
- Business fluent in English, basic speaker in German
- Advanced user familiarity with MS Office
- Ability to work independently, flexibility, solid commitment, good analytical skills, and interest in scientific research.
